**QUICK HISTORY:** Original HS and boiler room built in 1923; Wood Shop built in 1948; Metal Shop and the middle section of the HS built in 1966 (pit gym, front entry, classrooms); Built the media center in 1971; upstairs was HomeEc and Sewing; Connected Miller and Moore w/cafeteria and band room in 2004. OLD Washington built in 1893. NEW Washington added in 1956.
